## **County Durham**

The Channel Programme is a key part of the Prevent strategy. Section 36 of the Act requires local authorities and others to provide support for people who are vulnerable to being drawn into terrorism, before they commit an offence. This process, known as <a href="Channel">Channel</a>, operates in the pre-criminal space and aims to provide support to individuals at an early stage and help safeguard them from radicalisation.
